Instructions to order the data:

1. Open the study in the GESIS Search and click on “→ **Request data access**” under “**Actions**.”
2. Click on “Link to the form” and the data application form will open. Note: Some information about the study is already pre-filled.
3. Complete the online data application form, including details of any additional users, and submit it.
4. The application will be reviewed and, if there are no objections, approved.
5. After approval, GESIS data service will provide you the data.
