### Non-commercial usage

- The GESIS Panel does not accept any commercial data collection projects.
- Data collected within the GESIS Panel may be used for (non-commercial) scientific purposes only. Any partially or fully commercial usage is prohibited.

### Data protection

- GESIS – Leibniz Institute for the Social Sciences and all commissioned service providers work according to the regulations of the EU General Data Protection Regulation. Further, all statutory data protection provisions of the Federal Republic of Germany apply.
- Any attempt to de-anonymize data – that is, to try to identify individual respondents – is a criminal offense.
