IMPORTANT

The document that is presented in the form of a questionnaire is an image, which can be printed out on paper, which describes the EAPS data collection process as from the first quarter of 2021. On this document you can find the questions that are formulated and to whom, depending on the answers given throughout the interview.

It is necessary to bear in mind that this 'questionnaire' is not the instrument that is used during the interviews. These are carried out by running a computer application that is presented by the interviewer, on a laptop (for the first interviews) or PC (for successive interviews, principally carried out by telephone), outlining the text, the sequence of the questions, and the response options to be formulated to the interviewees. In addition, since Q1 2020, the CAWI method is being used to collect information of the survey.

With the mentioned computer application we avoid errors that could arise with the formulation of inadequate questions, depending on the characteristics of the person being interviewed, and it allows for the control of other types of errors that could arise as a result of the information provided by the interviewee.

In particular, **whenever 'reference week', 'the last four weeks', or 'next two weeks' are written in the text, the exact dates are mentioned in the interview**

In 2009 some specifications, to **reduce the respondent burden**, were added and they will be kept in the 2021 questionnaire. Thus, if certain constraints are fulfilled, the formulation of some questions can be avoided and, in consequence, the respondent burden is reduced. The questions that are not asked are copied from the information of the previous quarter (T-1) under certain conditions (as it was said above). Of course, it is necessary that there is certain stability in the situation of the respondent.

It is necessary that the person *was interviewed during the previous quarter* (ENCUAN=1) and that *the interview method used in the previous quarter was CATI* (METOAN=1) and that *the respondent in T-1 was the direct respondent* (PROXAN=1) or that, *if a proxy answered in T-1, he/ she was the same as in T* (IGPROX=1).

- In that case, questions about province of birth could be copied.
- For being able to copy questions about employment, it is necessary that some additional conditions are fulfilled, to assure that the employment is stable one.
- The same conditions are required in order to be able to copy questions about previous work experience.

All questions with salmon colour background refer to these specifications to reduce the respondent burden.

In addition, questions 8, 9 in section B or questions 3, 4 in section C that were added to allow us to recode some original professional status to the correct ones, will be kept in 2021 too.

Finally, new codes that were added in the past, just in case the respondent declare them and which were not read to the respondent, such as codes 7-9 in question 1 of section D or code 9 in question 6 of the same section, will be kept too.

Apart from that, some clarifications about variables used in the questionnaire are given below:

NENT	<u>Dwelling wave number</u> . It takes values from 1 to 6
CICLO	<u>Numerical identifier of the quarter to which the data refer</u> . It takes numeric values identifying each one with a given quarter. For example, CICLO=194 corresponds to the first quarter of 2021, CICLO=195 to the second and so on
EDAD	<u>Age</u> . In completed years
ENCUAN	<u>Surveyable in the previous quarter</u> . It takes values: 1 Yes 6 No
METOAN	<u>Method of conducting the interview in the previous quarter</u> . It takes values: 1 CATI 6 CAPI 9 CAWI
PROXAN	<u>Person who responded to the questionnaire in the previous quarter</u> . It takes values :

- 1 The person to whom the information refers
- 2 Another person in the household aged 16 and over
- 3 Refusal to answer

IGPROX

If the person who answers is the same or different from the one who did so in the previous quarter. It takes the values : 1 Yes 6 No 0 Does not know

All the question numbers with green background correspond to those annual questions asked only in the sixth wave

All the question numbers with orange background correspond to those biennial questions asked only in the sixth wave

The answer options with grey background must not be read out loud to the respondent and should only be coded when the respondent spontaneously declares them. Usually, these answer options correspond to the 'doesn't know' answer, but they are sometimes used in order to reduce the number of questions formulated to the respondent.

It is convenient to clarify that the texts that appear in brackets after the wording of each question are usually messages for the interviewer.

It should also be emphasized that when there are several statements for the same question, the conditions that must be fulfilled in order to read them are detailed before each one of them.

Finally, in question 8 of section D, codes appear in random order.
