Appropriate answers are underlined and the number printed against the corresponding answer is enclosed in a separate column for each person in the household. If there are squares in the "Code" column against a question, they are filled according to the content of the question.

If there is an arrow next to the code corresponding to the person's answer, the respondent should be asked the question with the indicated number; if nothing is written, the next question is asked
