VIOLATION OF Article 17 of the Law on Statistics of the Republic of Lithuania: PROCEDURES FOR "Natural persons, heads of enterprises, agencies or organisations and other persons THE SUBMISSION responsible for the preparation and provision of official statistical data who have **OF STATISTICAL** violated the requirements of this Law and other legal acts relating to statistics shall be DATA held liable in accordance with the procedure set forth by laws of the Republic of Lithuania."
